Fresh and vibrant. Elegant and crisp with delicious apricot and citrus.	
Cava Brut NV Francesc Ricart	£28.00
Elegant, soft body. Floral aroma with honeyed hints coming through. Well balanced fruit.	
Château Rives-Blanques, Blanquette de Limoux 2014 France	£35.80
A different sparkling wine made from the Mauzac grape. This well made sparkling wine is fresh, vibrant with apple and peach on the palate and a soft mousse. A great alternative to Champagne.	
Pierre Bertrand, 1er Cru Champagne NV 375ml	£32.40
A high proportion of Pinot Noir gives this Champagne weight and depth. Classical Champagne style of richness, brioche and floral notes on the palate.	
Pierre Bertrand, 1er Cru Champagne NV	£48.50
A high proportion of Pinot Noir gives this Champagne weight and depth. Classical Champagne style of richness, brioche and floral notes on the palate.	
Louis Roederer, Brut Premier NV Champagne	£81.00
One of the most famous Champagne houses, quality oozes out of this Brut Premier. Complex nutty, yeasty, brioche, biscuit flavours come through. An elegant wine with soft mousse.	
Dom Perignon, Vintage 2006 Champagne	£161.00

Whites

Verdejo - Tierra de Castilla Spain - Cal Y Canto Produced in La Mancha, Spain, from the Verdejo grape, this wine is rounded with vibrant favours of pear and apple.	£20.50
Pinot Grigio - Venezie Italy - Bella Modella A very fresh, light Pinot Grigio. Driven by citrus fruit and pear drops.	£23.00
Viognier - Languedoc France - Les Grand Bouillon Pretty aromas of yellow fruits such as peaches, citrus and pineapple with hints of linden and chamomile. The palate is lively, fruity and well-balanced, with good length.	£24.00
Vermentino - Languedoc France - Domaine les Yeuses Domaine les Yeuses is the source of our exceptionally good wines from the Languedoc- Roussillon, and they just get better with every vintage. Mediterranean in style with fresh, bright fruit favours.	£24.00
Sauvignon Blanc - Languedoc France - Domaine Gayda Vibrant nose of lemon, lime and tropical fruits, all underpinned by a streak of minerality that lifts and enhances the aromas. Clean and fresh on the palate with hints of grapefruit, mango and gooseberry with a long, crisp finish.	£26.50
Picpoul - Picpoul de Pinet France - Les Grand Bouillon A classical choice of wine with shell fish. This wine is produced very close to the sea resulting in a salty, steely citrus driven wine with high acidity.	£29.00
Chenin Blanc - Paarl South Africa - Vondeling "Petit Blanc" Grapes are hand-picked at night to retain the freshness of this wine. Floral, with a minty bouquet. Full bodied with quince and pear flavours with a lime finish.	£30.50
Alvarinho (Albarinho) & Tradjura - Minho Portugal - Leira Seca Clear citrus straw colour with greenish glints. Aromas of lemon and lime citrus fruits. The palate is robust, yet elegant, with traces of tropical fruits, crisp freshness and a good, clean, lengthy finish.	£30.60
Muscadet Sevre & Maine Sur Lie - Loire Valley France - Château de l'Oiselinière Classic pairing with seafood and creamy sauces. Muscadet Sevre & Maine Sur Lie spends longer on the lees giving the wine a yeasty, creamy texture. Subtle flavours of lemon, grapefruit and mineral undertones.	£31.00
Sauvignon Blanc - Marlborough New Zealand - Esk Valley A clean, fresh vibrant wine. Elegant flavours of gooseberry and grapefruit with herbal notes, nice acidity to finish.	£32.50
Grüner Veltliner - Wachau Austria - Domäne Wachau Grüner Veltliner is a wonderful grape and Austria are making some fantastic wines. Herbal notes and soft tropical fruits, yet good weight and roundness to the wine with a slight spice. Fantastic balance and beautifully produced. Try this with some scallops or oysters, you won't be disappointed.	£34.50
Domaine Fournillon Chablis, Burgundy France A classic Chablis, very terroir expressive. Chalky, mineral notes with rounded body. Citrus flavours with a mineral streak and refreshing acidity.	£35.00
Chardonnay - Limoux France - Château Rives Blanques "Odysée" This will go toe to toe with many great Burgundy wines. Rich style of wine with elegance. Flavours of vanilla, pear and apple with a rich mouth feel. A classy value for money wine.	£37.50
"Gentil" Noble Grapes - Alsace France - Hugel Gentil is a blend of all the Noble grapes from Alsace. A complex wine with more residual sugar. Very aromatic on the nose, with a rounded body, sweet tropical fruit with a little spice but all very subtle and well balanced. Great paired with something a little spicier such as oysters with Tabasco.	£38.00

Whites

Sauvignon Blanc - Sancerre Loire Valley France - Domaine Noël et Jean-Luc Raimbault, £38.50
A well made Sancerre, classical mineral side with a very vibrant and zesty body.
Gooseberry, lime and herbal notes on the palate and high refreshing acidity level.

Viognier - Eden Valley Australia - Tim Smith £42.00
A sought after producer with fantastic reputation. Rounded with good weight and texture,
clean flavours of apricots, peach and pear.

Rosé

Harmonie Rosé - Côtes de Gascogne - Domaine de Pellehaut £27.00
This wine is a blend of Tannat, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah. On the palate,
the wine has a big hit of alpine strawberries and melon. Soft and good weight with a dry finish.

Trilogie Rosé - Saint Chinian - Château Viranel £33.00
Trilogie Rosé is a blend of equal parts of Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cinsault. A light
blush rosé with soft fruits of creamy raspberry and strawberry. Delicate and refined.

Red

Cabernet Sauvignon - Stellenbosch South Africa - Ken Forrester £26.50
This Cabernet Sauvignon has a small percentage of Merlot that creates a youthful fresh
Bordeaux-styled blend showing ripe mulberries and plums with spicy, cigar box, undertones.
Very enjoyable with smooth and balanced tannins.

Tempranillo Rioja Crianza - Spain - Bodegas Isidro Milagro £27.50
A powerful yet smooth wine, classical Rioja style with oak integration being a Crianza
quality. Darker fruits with toasted notes and soft tannins.

Syrah - Languedoc France - Domaine Gayda £29.00
Very deep colour, opaque. Black pepper, liquorice and spice. A full bodied wine, with
layers of black fruits, pepper and moderate tannins. A fresh, clean, concentrated style
more akin to the cooler examples from Northern Rhône.

Malbec - Mendoza Argentina - Santa Ana £30.50
Malbec is big grape variety with dark fruits, spicy but a sweet cherry flavour lifting the wine.
Fantastic accompaniment to steaks.

Pinot Noir - Marlborough New Zealand – Taringi £32.00
Soft elegant pinot noir, velvety, soft style with savoury notes and raspberries and cherries on the palate.

Barbera - Piemonte Italy - Fontanafredda "Briccotondo" £34.00
From a fantastic area of Italy, Piemonte sings quality wine. Barbera is a dark grape with plum and
blackberries on the palate, spice and cinnamon with a nice texture and well integrated tannins.

Tempranillo Blend - Tierra de Castilla Spain - Cal Y Canto £20.50
Tempranillo, Syrah and Merlot make the blend of this wine. Fantastic value as this wine
offers a lot. Full bodied yet smooth with lots of dark fruits and spice.

Merlot - Central Valley Chile - Los Espinos £23.50
Purple-red wine of medium intensity. On the nose there are aromas of sweet blueberries, blackberries
and blackcurrant notes. On the palate it feels fresh, mature and elegant with a medium and delicate
structure. This Merlot is a lusciously textured, fruit packed wine with a soft, generous style.

Negroamaro - Salento Puglia Italy - Feudi di Guagnano, 'Terramare' £25.00
Negroamaro is an unusual grape but offers a lot. Well produced wine with soft berries
and slightly peppery smoky finish.

Sweet Wines

Domaine Treloar, Rivesaltes France 500ml

£27.70

A late-harvested, fortified sweet apéritif and/or dessert wine. It has a beautiful oral aroma and a rich honeyed palate with dried fruits and nuts. Treloar Muscat always aims to be less sugary and have more richness than others.

Château Gravas, Sauternes Bordeaux France 750ml

£46.00

The clay and limestone soils of this Haut Barsac vineyard provide the best environment for the Sémillon grown here. The fogs coming in from the local rivers shroud the vineyards and encourage the development of a serendipitous act of nature - noble rot. This fungus attacks the water of the ripe grapes, leaving only the sugars - one of the most important objectives in the vineyard.
